

PRIVACY NOTICE FOR THE CONDUCTOR COMPETITION

1 PURPOSE OF THE NOTICE

The purpose of this Notice is to provide information about the privacy and processing principles used by the Budapest Festival Orchestra (hereinafter: Controller or BFO) for competitions.

The BFO processes your personal data in your application submitted to the email address karmesterkerestetik@bfz.hu.

3 LEGAL BASIS AND PURPOSE OF PROCESSING

Processing is performed based on your voluntary, informed consent, which also includes your express consent to the use of your personal data provided during registration for the competition.

Legal basis for the processing: voluntary consent of the Data Subject as per Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR. You may withdraw your consent at any time whatsoever by sending an email to the email address: karmesterkerestetik@bfz.hu.

The purpose of the processing: applying for and fulfilling the competition announced. The Controller may only use the data provided by you for the specific purpose – the implementation of the relevant competition.

The Controller will and may not use such personal data for a different purpose. Your personal data may only be disclosed to third persons with your prior express consent, unless required by binding law.

The BFO will not check personal data provided to it. Correctness and accuracy of the data provided are the responsibility of the person providing them.

4 DURATION OF PROCESSING

Personal data provided by you will be processed until completion or withdrawal of the professional review following the implementation of the competition.

5 PERSONS ACCESSING THE DATA, DATA TRANSFER, PROCESSING

The Controller and its internal staff members who need to access and process the data in order to perform their job-related tasks are entitled to access the data.

6 THE DATA SUBJECT'S RIGHTS AND ENFORCING THEM

You may request rectification or erasure of your incorrectly captured personal data any time by contacting the Controller using any of its contact details provided.

You may also object to the processing of your personal data. The Controller will review your objection within the shortest time possible from the submission of the request, but within 30 days at the latest, make a decision regarding the soundness of your objection, and notify you in writing.

You may also lodge a complaint with the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (H-1125 Budapest, Szilágyi Erzsébet fasor 22/C.; www.naih.hu).
